

Hebron Conservation Commission - Minutes  
May 17, 2018

Martha called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

Guest: Daniel Geiger - Oak Hill Environmental Services

Martha introduced Dan Geiger of Oak Hill Environmental Services. Dan has been retained by the Onaway Board of Directors to evaluate the property and recommend and implement improvements to continue to protect the wetlands, lake, and watershed. He shared maps, photos and plot plan. He will be evaluating septic systems on the property, as well as wetlands and erosion. He shared maps and photos.

He is working with John McGee from Fish and Game about which fish are spawning in stream, and Amy from the Natural Heritage Bureau (Div. of Forest and Lands) who will help evaluate and recommend native plantings along the shore. He defined the work as a betterment project.

Conservation commission members will tour the property on May 31 at 9 am. Entrance is through main gate.
